Reverend Kenneth Wayne Little, 83 of the New Canaan Community, Arab, passed away Monday May 6, 2024. Reverend Little was born in Blount County March 13, 1941. He graduated from Susan Moore High School in 1959. He was a Missionary Baptist Preacher and Pastor for many years. He pastored 9 churches: Friday's Crossing twice, Macedonia, Brooksville twice, New Home, New Emmaus, Plainview twice, Friendship, Harmony and New Canaan.
